The principal office of the British American Land Company is located here, the Hazy River is capable of being used for manufacturing purposes from the extensive falls.</p> <p>It must be borne in mind that all those persons residing in Sherbrooke are not permanent inhabitants, but merely labourers on the Railway.</p> <p>The British American Land Company owns most of the Land & Town lots in that place.</p>
