The settlement of this Township is greatly retarded for the want of roads. There is not a foot of road made in the whole Township. There have settled there have suffered & continue to suffer, great hardships for the want of roads. The settlers on the east side of the Township, have no market nearer than Decker, which is at a distance of one hundred & ten miles from them. The road which they have to travel to go thither, intersects or joins the Kender road, this by six miles distant from the line of this Township, I am informed by the settlers, that for the greater part of the above mentioned 36 miles, the road is very bad. Most of the settlers on the west side of the Township, have to travel nine miles, four of which is through swamp, before they get to the road constructed by the B. & S. Company in the adjoining Township of Liverpool. During the summer of 1848, the Surveyor who was sent to survey this Township, surveyed a road from Lake St. Francis (running through the middle of the settlement) to intersect or join the road above mentioned. Made by the B. & S. Company through the Township of Liverpool, & thence to Shabrook, but no part of it has yet been made. I should strongly recommend this road to be made, as it would facilitate the settlement of this & the adjoining Township, being the most direct route from Lake St. Francis to the west side which is done, in consequence of the St. Lawrence & Atlantic Railroad coming there, & flourishing
