<p>Mr. Daniel Carman is in possession of an extensive Water Power Saw Mill the cost amounting to \$1500. and requires about nine hands the year round to keep it in operation, will saw two thousand feet of Lumber every 24 hours this Mill is situated in the West end of the Flourishing Village of Rathcar, and is supplied with a never failing stream by the Grand Jacques Canal, which runs through that fine Village.</p>		<p>Within the limits of my boundary there is no new and prosperous village springing up which bid fair to become a place of great note, it is only about seven years since the village of Rathcar was first started and there are now five large merchant shops, several Groceries, two Taverns, one large Flouring and custom Water Mill with four run of stones, one large Stone Hammer which cost about three hundred pounds Mr. Philip Carman the Proprietor is carrying on a heavy business in that line perhaps five or seven hundred pounds a year & a primary school by the Mr. Henderson which where all the branches of education are taught the Board has made a present to the trustees appointed by Mr. Carman who himself built the house and made a bequest of it to the trustees for the purpose of appointing an education that an usually great attendance from thirty to forty scholars, and the number of scholars would be greatly increased if there were more interest in the education of their children.</p> <p>Mr. Wm.
