		<p>The land in the west part of the Township of Matilda is generally of a sandy nature and not so good for agriculture purposes as the center and east part of the township the front part of my district is very well cultivated and a number of good stone and frame houses about the center of the west part of the township along the Edwardsburgh township line there are but very few inhabitants owing to the land being swampy in some parts. The rear part of the district is wholly a new settlement with scarcely anything but stumps and a few small clearings but the land is tolerable good and the new settlement presents a healthy appearance the cause of such being light crops in that part of the township was owing to a very heavy hail storm that fell over in the month of July which has ruined almost everything in its course whole fields of grain was wholly destroyed and some that was not destroyed totally was scarcely worth harvesting with the exception the crops in general are good with the exception of the potato crop which was a great failure and in many cases were not harvested at all there is no merchantile business done in my district as there is not one store and but very little manufacturing of any kind and is principally devoted to agriculture. My district is bounded on the front by the town of Edwardsburgh, County of Grenville on the north the St. Lawrence River cuts through corner of the township of Matilda and runs through the township of Mountain which township bounds the north or rear of the township of Matilda.
