		<p>rem. con. fr. 1 sheet</p> <p>There are 5 large mercantile establishments all doing good business, a flour &amp; saw-mill, a small factory or fulling establish. 2 Taverns, 1 Temperance Hotel, 1 good School House, a Catholic Chapel, and an Episo. Methodist Chapel are in the course of erection the former built of stone &amp; lime is capable of holding 500 persons, and the latter, a frame building, capable of holding 200 persons; considerable business is done in this village during the rafting season as all the timber rafts through from the branches of the Weston and other streams, on its course to the Ottawa &amp; St. Lawrence rivers. One settlement of Irish Emigrants (formerly prosperous) were ruined by the conflagration which occurred in the summer of 1849 which totally destroyed all they had in stock &amp; property, but burnt the surface of the ground, &amp; left a barren waste behind, the few who remained seem not to have recovered the shock as yet.</p> <p>A number of buildings put up within the last 2 years and otherwise improved.</p>
