		<p>The Fifth Ward of the Township of Clarke, on the South by the line between the fourth and fifth concessions being at No 21. to 35. inclusive. on the West by the Town line between Darlington and Clarke, on the North by the Township boundaries on the East by the side line between No 20, and 21 to front of fifth concession, including fifteen lots and six concessions the 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> concessions of which are mostly all settled upon a great part of the 9<sup>th</sup> and five lots in the 10<sup>th</sup>. the 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> &amp; 8<sup>th</sup> con. are mostly strong heavy clay bottom mixed with limestone gravel well adapted for growing Fall wheat the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> and part of the 8<sup>th</sup> are of lighter sandy soil not so well adapted for farming purposes and give little return. The land is badly watered, much broken and the timber is chiefly oak and small pine, whereas on the 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> &amp; 8<sup>th</sup> it is chiefly Maple, Birch, Buck, Elm and ash the land well watered and productive. The value of good land where there is good buildings on it in the first four concessions of the ward is from \$5. to \$7.10 per acre the other two concessions from 1\$ to \$3. per acre. There is one valuable creek which runs from Manners to the Lake (Ontario) through the whole breadth of Clarke between Nos 29. and 32. and several smaller ones fall into it and many good sites for water power on it not taken up yet. The Roads in it are as good as in many places so nearly settled 9. 10<sup>th</sup> of this has been settled on within the last twelve years. Thomas Waddell</p>
