		<p>This Enumeration district comprises the second concession Mile square and Western addition of the Township of Kingston the second concession runs across the Township from the Eastern addition to the Mile square thence the Western addition to the rear of the Township forming an angle on two sides of the third Enumeration district it is bounded north by Portland and the third concession east by the Township and city limits south by the City limits the first concession and river St. Lawrence and West by Ernestown</p> <p>From the city limits on the south side of the second concession commences the Kingston and Espaner Macadamised Road which runs about north east to the village of Waterloo the distance of two miles thence west along the concession for one mile and a half, on these three and a half miles are two toll gates which are a source of great complaint and annoyance to the people of the Townships as well as to this Enumeration district, the road then diverges about south south west across a corner of the third concession of the Township then passing through the Enumeration district on the third concession Western addition There is another Macadamised road commencing at the same place and called the Bath Road which runs west between the first and third concessions untill it reaches the bay called Collins Bay, it then diverges around the Bay running along the shore to the extremity of the mile square Western addition these are the only Macadamised roads although there are two others in contemplation which it is supposed will be finished next summer the first will commence at the south east corner of the second concession running north along the boundary one and three eighths of a mile then along the concession to the village of Waterloo, this road is generally travelled especially in winter by persons wishing to avoid snowdrifts and toll gates, to obviate this the Council in their wisdom have thought it expedient to erect a toll gate to prevent persons from avoiding the toll gate on the main road, This road is the Portland road which runs across two concessions on the north east corner of the Western addition these are the only roads I will at present describe although in every part of this Enumeration district there are a sufficient number of concession and cross roads</p>
