		(No) This person was one of the first settlers in Kingston he was born at Crown Point Lake George near Lake Champlain when the territory of the United States belonged to Great Britain his father was surgeon and Physician in the British Army and stationed at that place he recollects the incident of the barracks taking fire and the blowing up of the Magazine at Crown Point the surrender of the territory now belonging to the United States and consequently their removal to Kingston Canada where he has resided ever since
		For the above reasons I have written the place of birth British America although the place at present is in the territory of the United States
