This District as seen above contains five Concessions of the township extending from East to West six miles from North to South seven miles —

Bounded in front or South by the Kingston and Napanee Macadamised Road, and the Road between the second & third concessions of the township — North by Loughborough and Stormont — West by a line called the Western Addition of the township of Kingston and East by another you called the Eastern Addition —

Intersected by a small creek running a S.W. course from Collins Lake in Stormont, to the Bay of Quinte emptying into that part of said Bay called Collins Bay at M. Guin's Mill.

The principal roads are the Kingston and Napanee Road leading to Toronto, and the Waterloo and Lyndenham Road, Macadamised about six miles north from the Napanee Road, leading to the township of Stormont on the East and Loughborough on the North of the same road after running north 16 miles divides to the West running to the township of Portland and is then called the Portland Road — After passing the Macadamised part of this road it becomes very rough and is a great hindrance to the travel and settlement of the rear townships —

This section is better adapted to Grass than Grain, being a soil inclined to clay and rather cold.

It abounds in limestone.

The Grist Mill is conveniently situated in the center of the township on the Glabe, owned by E. & W. Jackson from the Donable the Archdeacon G. O. Stuart — the water in summer is sometimes rather scanty — the flour made equals any in the Province.
