		<p>The front part of this Enumeration District is principally all settled and the soil is of an excellent quality. The village of Stephentown is located on a part of lots 10, 11, 12, 13, and 14 in the fifth concession in which there is an excellent water privilege on which a first class Saw Mill, Distillery and Woollen factory were erected. The stone on this part of the Enumeration District is principally lime stone back to the rear of the seventh concession. Much of the remaining part is under water by lakes or marshes, the soil is some what broken, however when soil is to be found it is of a good quality. There is at least three water privileges suitable for saw mills and considerable pine and oak timber can be got. It is supposed by many that the rear part of this Township contains large quantities of Ore of different kinds such as Iron, Lead and no doubt Silver &amp;c. A considerable quantity of good land can be found in the rear of this township and perhaps prospects at some being settled in my opinion only the part of the</p>
