		<p>In this Enumeration District the land is generally of a fair average quality, in concessions 1st, 2nd and part of 3rd there is great capability of receiving settlers there being only a few families thereon and the greater part being under wood the remainder of this District is nearly all taken up or claimed.</p> <p>There is a river running in a North East direction across Lots 27 and 28 in the 3rd concession, and 28 and 29 in the 2nd concession, and 30 in the 1st concession until it empties itself into the Rideau River nearly where the 45th parallel of North Latitude crosses that River, it is called the South Branch of the Rideau, and is at present navigable for small Steamers up to the village of Kempsville a distance of 4 miles from its junction with the Rideau. There are some obstructions to the navigation at low water, but the Inhabitants of Kempsville are taking means to have them removed. The Prescott and Bytown Railway runs in a North-easterly direction across Lot 27 in the 4th con. and 27 and 28 in the 3rd con. till it touches the South Branch in Lot 28th in the 3rd con. There is land cleared for a station. The Municipal Council of this Township took £6000 stock in said Railway Company,</p>
