		<p>With regard to any remarks that can be made respecting this Enumeration district it can be of little importance to the Government, however small as the district is the quality of land varies, but in a general view, its value may be estimated at from 5 to 9 dollars per acre, and within the bounds of the small district there is not less than twelve hundred acres of dead Swamp good for nothing except many farms remarkably heavy, the main Mississippi crosses this district at one end forming a lake on the 7th and 8th Concessions of three miles wide the other parts are very badly watered. I wish to remark that the people cannot in general be persuaded but the Agricultural Census is only a preparation for further taxation and therefore in my opinion are not willing to return the full amount of the produce of the land but if it be of any importance to the Government of the Country I think you might at least add one sixth to the produce appearing on this roll, the roll contains the full amount given in by the people, I used all my endeavours to persuade them against the notion of taxation having any thing to do with the Census roll but persuaded a man against his will, he will be of the same opinion or notion still,</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Patrick Dawsdall Enumerator</p>
