		<p>On the 12th January 1852 I did my instructions as enumerated Division No 2 in the Township of Elizabeth Town being composed of the 6th 7th 8th 9th 10th & 11th Conceptions and I commenced my operations at 12 O'clock Noon. The weather clear and strong snow was on top throughout the week with heavy falls of wind from the N.W. and N.E. the 11th blow the snow and not one fair day. Monday the 1st continued my Stout weather and extremely cold and bad roads but further degrading impeded my progress the snow from two to two and a half feet deep and quantity making from 4 to 60 Lams per day loaded with square timber for 13 cart loads Wood & single bolts further in heavy conceptions the farmers have located them in the timber their sets I have traversed my through snow drifts nice side to my home for instance these that live in the center would not venture out until the storm subsided but I had to turn the tenant and further more confounding Occurrence many times that place driving up to a lonely but snow blowing in every direction I tried my best to the State and Roflet at the door a feminine voice come in after the usual "Is Mr at home" in Madam Reply No, I called to take his personal and agricultural business the of which appears in the countenance and the whole of them apparently conveyed the aspect reminded me of a regular Vienna Oh! more taxes it in such laws will Madam you will have to go to tell your husband to be at home tomorrow I will be at home this way he will not stay at home for you the storm increased and being inclined to rather than figure lock myself off in a few days I later On her husband and found a watch for his clear composition determined me for three quarters of an hour in a vision Replies, this is not the only Occurrence of a similar nature I have been detained for the term of one hour when I could not the services in one path but with them that than proceeds</p>
