<p>This was a first mill with one run of stones, wrought by steam, but now dismantled. Owing to embarrassed circumstances the proprietor, by mutual agreement with his creditor, sold the mill by public sale, which brought \$275.00 which was considered very cheap, with a view to increase trade, the present proprietor sold the engine in 1857 for \$250.00, intending to replace it with one which would drive two run of stones, and a saw mill, which has not been carried into execution, owing to the pendency of a Chancery suit, instituted by the former proprietor against his creditor and the present proprietor for unpaid. I cannot say what was the first cost. The mill was sold either in the end of 1849 or beginning of 1850, and erected in 1846. The building is frame. Henry Syche proprietor.</p>
