General Remarks of Enumerators:

The River Thames, in its course through Blanchard, affords an abundant supply of water power at the distance of every half mile, a mile or other. Machinery might be easily be placed, while the inexhaustible stores of limestone rock afford the greatest facilities for building. Its water, its steam and the fertility of its soil, which is seldom surpassed, are the great resources of the Township.
