The undersigned enumerator in giving this return, would be to remark that as soon as he examined his sheets it seemed to him that there was an oversight in having in the column for yellow ground that which was under fall wheat but which bore no crop in 1851, or for acres of Meadow and for such land in the column for cultivated land, would prevent the amount of the return to be completed in the schedule there was therefore an alternative but to return yellow ground as wild land, the acres of Meadow were included in the column for Pasture so that the quantity returned as pasture included all land under grass and of the quantity returned as wild land a certain part will be yellow land. The soil of the 1st Division with almost of the same depth, very rolling land clay soil mixed with limestone gravel forming a rich and fertile soil, and capable of producing a far heavier crop than these returns will show, with the exception of three thousand acres of Swamp nearly all in one block.

Education is somewhat restricted here being but two schools in this Division, crime is unknown, there is but one resident Clergyman in this Division.
