Enumeration District No. 1
of the Township of Downie comprises
lot No. 5 on 1st to lot No. 5 on 14th Con^{ts}
and Gore of said Township, inclusive.
It is bounded on the North by the
road leading from the Village of
Stratford to Goderich; on the
South by the Town line between
the Township of Gore & Humber; on
the East by the Town line between
South East Gore and the Gore of
Downie; and on the West by the section
line between lots 5 & 6 of said Township.

There are two public roads
through the district - one from Strat-
ford to the Town of Woodstock in
Ontario - the other from Stratford to
the Village of St. Marys in Brantford.

The general character of the land in
the district is a fine rolling surface
the soil for the most part a rich
loam, sandy in some parts, but all
capable of being made a fine wheat
country - the timber generally consists
of hard wood interspersed with
Black Ash swells - there is very
little pine in the district. It is not
however well watered, there being
only two small creeks running
through the district - the fore part
of the district includes about the 1/2
part of the village of Stratford, there
are two places of worship - the Pres-
byterian Church of Canada. There
is a very general want of schools in
the district there being only three
in operation at present.

I have much satisfaction in
being able to state that the com-
mission of crime in this district
is not prevalent - there are of
course many petty assaults, but
we get no crime of any magnitude
has as yet been committed.
