Section 49, it is enacted "that every occupant of any house, or of any distinct story, apartment or room, shall be left—shall fill up the same to the best of his or her knowledge or belief, and sign the same, and deliver the same to the Enumerator when required, or some other member of the family, if any of them be capable of so doing, shall fill up and sign and deliver the same as aforesaid when required, or who shall wilfully or without lawful excuse refuse or neglect to fill up such Schedule, to the best of his or her knowledge or belief, or who shall wilfully or without lawful excuse make, sign or deliver, or cause to be made, signed or delivered, any such Schedule, shall thereby incur a penalty of not less than five shillings."

It is the duty of the Registrar to rigidly to enforce the observance of the foregoing clause.

Every person who abode in the house on the night of Sunday, January the 11th, 1852—whether the person be a resident or a casual visitor, and stating in Col. No. 5, whether such residence be permanent or casual, and also every person usually resident, but then casually absent, distinguishing such persons from others.
