The several Enumerators have express orders rigidly to enforce the observance of the foregoing clause.

This Schedule is to contain the names of every person who abode in the house on the night of Sunday, January the 11th, 1852 - whether the same be settled residents or transient passengers having their permanent residence elsewhere, and stating in Col. No. 5, whether such residence be in Upper or Lower Canada—and also every person usually resident, but then casually absent, distinguishing such persons from others.
