 deliver the same to him, and every such occupant who shall wilfully or without lawful excuse refuse or neglect to fill up such S
 of his or her knowledge and belief, or to sign and deliver the same as aforesaid when required, or who shall wilfully make, sign
 to be made signed or delivered, any false return of all or any of the matters specified in any such Schedule, shall thereby incur

The several Enumerators have express orders rigidly to enforce the observance of the foregoing clause.
