## INTRODUCTION

Educator, author and public speaker, George Elmore Reaman was born in Concord, Ontario of Pennsylvania German and Yorkshire English parentage. After receiving his Ph.D. from Cornell University, in 1913, he took a position as lecturer with Moose Jaw College in Saskatchewan. He remained there until 1918, when he became Education Editor with Macmillan of Canada. In 1925 he founded the Bowmanville Boys' Training School, where he worked until the school was closed, during the Depression. In 1939 he joined the Department of English, Ontario Agricultural College in Guelph. He became professor of English at Waterloo College in 1954, and remained there until 1959, when he joined the University of Waterloo as Head of Adult Education.

Dr. Reaman wrote *English Grammar for New Canadians*, 1932, *The Trail of the Black Walnut*, 1957, *The Trail of the Huguenots*, 1964, *A History of Agriculture in Ontario*, 1970, as well as 14 other books and numerous articles. He was founder of the Ontario Genealogical Society and the Pennsylvania German Folklore Society of Ontario. His membership in educational and/or cultural associations include the Canadian Authors' Association and the International Platform Association. In his research, his publications and public addresses he examined the problems of child adjustment, the education of immigrants, and explored and publicized the contributions of groups of non-British origin to Canada's development.
