## INTRODUCTION

Dmytro Pyluk was born on March 9, 1900 in Wysocke-Brody in western Ukraine. He emigrated to Canada in May, 1928. He lived and worked in Edmonton, Winnipeg, Toronto and Vancouver. In Winnipeg, he became involved in various Ukrainian cultural activities and produced *Bethlehem Star*, the first Ukrainian-language film in Winnipeg. He travelled across Canada showing his film to various Ukrainian communities in 1940 and again in 1945-46. In the early 1950's, he bought a farm and raised his family near Ottawa. He died in October, 1985 in Ottawa.
